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Public kiosks available for Illinois Health Insurance Marketplace enrollment

Walk-ins requiring minimal assistance accepted on first-come-first-served basis Tuesdays now to March 24

BLOOMINGTON, Ill.—The McLean County Health Department has two public computer kiosks available every Tuesday for individuals requiring minimal assistance with online enrollment. Students from Illinois State University School of Social Work will be available to assist individuals using the kiosks, providing additional enrollment opportunities in McLean County.

The public kiosks will be open Tuesdays from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. from now to March 24 on a first-come, first-served basis, with ISU School of Social Work student volunteers available to assist enrollees. Individuals requiring additional assistance are encouraged to schedule an appointment with an In-Person Counselor from the McLean County Health Department or LIFE-CIL.

“As we approach the March 31st enrollment deadline, the public kiosks will offer another opportunity within our community to access coverage”, Laura Beavers, Community Outreach Coordinator, said. “The kiosks are ideal for technology savvy people who do not have access to a computer and are Medicaid eligible.”

Individuals planning to apply for affordable health insurance coverage with use of the health department public kiosks should bring with them:

1. A Photo I.D.
2. Social Security Card
3. Proof of immigration status (if applicable)
4. Most current proof of income (if applicable) for each person applying for coverage

The In-Person Counseling Program will continue to provide counseling and hands-on enrollment assistance to individuals who need help navigating the online enrollment system through scheduled appointments.
