Chairman McIntyre presented for approval a request to approve the Class A Liquor License Application for Green Gables. Taylor Williams presented the application and noted applicant had not presented an application for the annual renewal because of the fire at that location. However, they need to keep the license up to date because of State regulations. Mr. Soeldner asked if design of new building would affect this license. Ms. Williams stated it would not. Mr. Soeldner asked if this would cover a beer garden. Ms. Williams indicated they would have to come back for approval of that class of license. Ms. Schafer asked her to confirm State gaming license regulations was main reason they were asking for this license. Ms. Williams confirmed. Mr. Soeldner asked her to confirm liquor license was required by the State for a gaming license. Ms. Williams confirmed.
