Due to the COVID-19 response, the McLean County Health Department's Vital Records program will only be providing birth certificates by mail from March 20 through the end of March. We will re-evaluate this procedure at that time. The procedure for obtaining a birth certificate by mail are on the page below.

It is important that you send a copy of your photo ID either by mail with the application or by email to vitalrecords@mcleancountyil.gov when you pay by a credit card.

- Adding a child to insurance
- Passport for travel
- Enrollment in daycare
