McLean County Health Department (MCHD) Activities

- Coordinating with the McLean County Emergency Management Agency to lead an Alternate Housing Coalition to ensure that housing is available to isolate, quarantine or protect vulnerable populations during the COVID-19 response

- Hiring staff to support increased contact tracing, including a Project Director, Epidemiologist, Contact Tracing Supervisor and Contact Tracers
