## COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic Added in McLean County

Bloomington, IL—In partnership with Carle BroMenn Medical Center, McLean County Health Department (MCHD) will open additional appointment slots for online scheduling Friday morning at 9:00 AM for residents who need the first dose of the vaccine. The additional clinic will be held on Friday, February 12 at the ARC (Activity & Recreation Center) located at 600 E. Willow Street in Normal. Please note that ARC staff is not involved with scheduling vaccinations or operating the clinics.

McLean County residents who qualify for Phases [1A and 1B](#) are encouraged to:

- Go online to the MCHD website ([health.mcleancountyil.gov](http://health.mcleancountyil.gov)) to book an appointment (if you have access to a computer); or,
- Call the MCHD COVID-19 call center at (309) 888-5600 which is available Mon-Fri between 9AM and 4PM (if you do not have computer access and need assistance booking an appointment).

MCHD has added a tutorial to the above-mentioned webpage that explains the steps necessary from start to finish so residents can be certain they completed the registration process. Those who use the website to register will also receive an email confirmation of their appointment.
