**Today's COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic Cancelled Due to Late Shipment  
Rescheduled for Friday**

Bloomington, IL— The COVID-19 vaccine clinic that was originally scheduled for today (Wednesday, March 3) has been rescheduled for Friday, March 5 at the same location (ARC – Activity & Recreation Center in Normal). All participants are scheduled for the same appointment time.

Those who registered via email have been updated at the same email address they provided when they registered. A small number of those who registered using the MCHD call center are being contacted via the call center. No further action is needed to *confirm* a rescheduled appointment. Instructions on how to reschedule the appointment should there be a conflict are included in the email or phone call messages.

This clinic is for residents receiving their second doses of Pfizer vaccine, which recommends receiving the second dose 21 days after receiving the first dose. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the second dose of the Pfizer vaccine may be administered up to six weeks (42) days after the first dose.
